Rapha Children's Home was founded on August 27, 1998 by the Kuantan Pastors and Leaders Fellowship and is now home to 31 children aged from two to 19-years old. Its objective is to provide care for underprivileged and abused children as well as orphans and the home is manned by five full time staff - a supervisor, a chef, a driver and two general staff.

Encik Aziz stressed that the club consistently contribute and help charitable organisations throughout the country.

He added, "We have an annual programme and KAG allocates a sum of money for this purpose. We contribute cash as well as organise events to bring cheer and joy to the needy and the underprivileged."

Earlier, the KAG Treasure Hunt 2010 saw 91 teams participating with a total of 372 participants. The treasure hunt was flagged off at 730 am in Bukit Kiara by Encik Aziz.

Participants went through a four-hour journey to Kuantan, Pahang while trying to decipher the tulips and solve anagrams. At the same time, it was one way for KAG members to get to know Kuantan and also, the sights and sounds heading to Kuantan.
