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AmBank Group Celebrates AmFamily Fiesta 2013

AmBank Group today organised AmFamily Fiesta 2013, the Central Region Family Day gathering at Stadium Merdeka, Kuala Lumpur. The Family Day saw a record number of staff, totalling 7,602 people comprising Klang Valley staff and their family members in attendance, the largest number of staff in attendance among all six Regional Family Days within AmBank Group.

The presence of AmBank Group Chairman Tan Sri Azman Hashim and wife YM Tunku Arishah Tunku Maamor, and senior management from various business units made the Family Day gathering all the more significant.

The last Family Day for the Central Region which covers the Klang Valley area, was held in 2010 at the same venue. This year's Family Day saw more people attending compared to the 2010 event where 6,324 people attended.

Tan Sri Azman said, "The Family Day is in essence, a recognition of the contribution of our staff towards the growth of the Group. It also affords us an opportunity for all of us to mingle outside the office environment whilst getting to know one another even better seeing that the biggest Family Day group is located in the Klang Valley. This is indeed an opportune occasion for all us, so let's make the most out of it".

He also thanked the contribution made by the Central Region staff towards the Group success, both in business and also the Group's prowess in the sporting arena. Out of the 7,602 attendees, 1,640 are employees of AmBank Group coming from various subsidiaries within the Group such as AmBank (M) Berhad and AmIslamic Bank with 818 staff, AmInvestment Bank with 133 staff, AmGeneral Insurance with 142 staff, AmLife

Insurance and AmFamily Takaful with 150 staff, Group Shared Services with 116 staff, Kurnia Insurans (Malaysia) Berhad with 249 staff and 32 staff from MBF Cards (M'sia) Sdn Bhd.

For the first time, staff from the recently acquired Kurnia Insurans (Malaysia) Berhad and MBF Cards (M'sia) Sdn Bhd were also present, affirming the Group's welcome of the staff into the AmBank Group family.

The main activities for the Family Day included among others, four song and dance performances by the AmBank Group staff, Children's Colouring Contest, Tele-matches, inflatables and various fun-filled activities for staff and their children, not forgetting the ever-popular lucky draw which offers many valuable prizes and the fireworks display.

Tan Sri Azman Hashim also distributed zakat as part of AmIslamic Bank's total business zakat contribution for the financial year ending March 2012 amounting to RM1,313,553 to 10 charity homes and organisation. (Attached is the list of charity homes and organisation)

There was also performances by popular local artistes such as Mizz Nina, Aliya and The Singing Shop to add a touch of glamour to the proceedings.
